- The emergency alarm is a 30 sec. bell sound in 10 sec. intervals.
- Emergency exits are marked with green signs.
- The Emergency exits on this floor are situated.....
- The evacuation guides with yellow jackets will guide you.
- The assembly point of this floor is the Orient canteen (U)
- Stay at the assembly point and await further notice.
- The fire extinguishers on this floor are marked with red signs n and are placed....

Safety, Valby Assembly points


Assembly Points: (Marked with a red circle on the drawing)

•The E Canteen (Nordica) is assembly point for the buildings mentioned below: A, C (the ground floor) D, G, SB, SC, U, Q and BA (the DEMO-lab).

•The U canteen (Orient) is assembly point for the buildings mentioned below: B, L, SA and E (the basement to the 5th floor).

•The basement of the SC building is assembly point for the building mentioned below:


E (the 6th to the 11th floor).
